VACCINE CONSIDERATIONS/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

6 MONTHS – 21 YEARS	Influenza (during the fall and winter season)
MENACTRA #2	If first dose given at 13 - 15 years old, booster given at 16 - 18 years old If first dose given at 16 years or older, no booster is needed
GARDASIL 9	If child is 11 - 14 years old they get a 2 shot series (initial and 6 months later) If the child is 15 years old or older they get a 3 shot series (initial, 2 and 6 months later)
HEPATITIS A	Children 2-18 years old get .5 ml dose, 19 and over get 1.0 ml. Both ages get a 2 shot series (initial and 6 months later)
HEPATITIS B	Children 2-19 years old get .5 ml dose, 20 and over get 1.0 ml. Both ages get a 3 shot series (initial, 1-2 months, and 6 months later)
