 Gardasil 9 (HPV9) - human papilloma virus

### VACCINE CONSIDERATIONS/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

6 MONTHS – 21 YEARS	Influenza (during the fall and winter season)
GARDASIL 9	If child is 11 - 14 years old they get a 2 shot series (initial and 6 months later) If the child is 15 years old or older they get a 3 shot series (initial, 2 and 6 months later)
HEPATITIS A	Children 2-18 years old get .5 ml dose, 19 and over get 1.0 ml. Both ages get a 2 shot series (initial and 6 months later)
BEXSERO	Child needs 2 doses at least 1 month apart. This is an optional vaccine that needs to be discussed with the provider.
COVID-19	The recommendations for the primary series of the COVID vaccine and booster doses vary by age
